COURSE AIM

This unit is based on the National Standard for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work and involves the skills and knowledge required to operate a forklift, including checking forklift condition, driving the forklift to fulfil operational requirements, monitoring site conditions and monitoring and maintaining forklift performance.

COURSE CONTENT

- Compliance with WHS legislation
- Communicate and work safely with others in the work area
- Hazard identification and control
- Conduct pre-startup, operational, shut down and secure checks according to procedures
- Operate the forklift truck and manoeuvre loads safely, picking up and placing loads at various stack heights
- Calculations

COURSE COMPLETION

Upon successful completion participants will receive a Nationally Recognised Statement of Attainment and a SafeWork photo card will be issued via post.
