COURSE AIM

Students will obtain the skills and knowledge required to make decisions about the safety of occupants during a facility emergency and how to give instructions on the priority of order for responding to an emergency incident.

This includes leading the preparation of facility emergency procedures, commanding, controlling and coordinating facility emergency response procedures and responses and concluding the facility emergency incident.

COURSE CONTENT

- Prepare for an emergency in a facility
- Identify possible emergency situations
- Identify emergency actions in accordance with facility emergency plan
- Maintain and update emergency response procedures
- Assess emergencies and initiate action plans in accordance with facility emergency procedures
- Monitor evacuation processes
- Implement processes for occupants to return to the facility
